On August 13th at the Covington Firehouse the Class of 1996 gathered and shared their lives and enjoyed good times with former classmates.





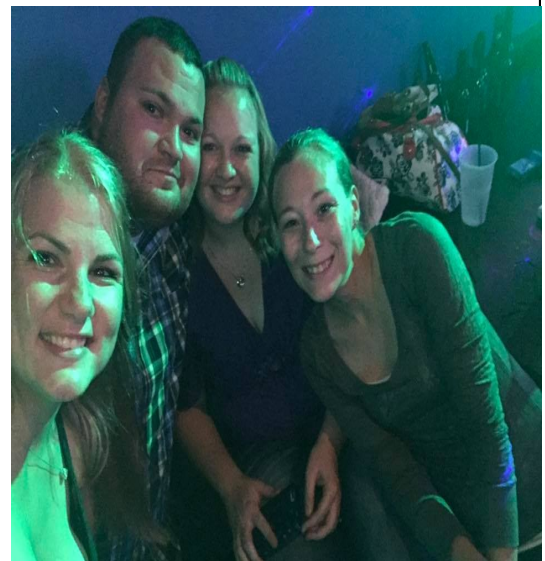
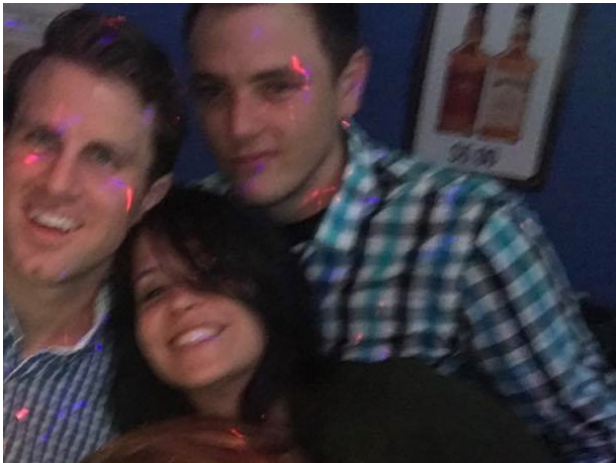
# Class of 2001
